- Programs for adults, including, but not limited to, older adults, that are primarily related to entry or reentry into the workforce
- Programs for adults, including, but not limited to, older adults to develop knowledge and skills to assist elementary and secondary children to success academically in school.
- Education programs for adults with disabilities
- Short-term career technical education programs with high employment potential
- Programs for apprentices (internship)
